What is **DIGITAL INTIMACY?**

A sonic and visual immersive experience of the accessibility and ease of exploitation of personal information.




What is the IMMERSIVE EXPERIENCE? *

Visitors enter the exhibition space designed as a familiar room in a home reminiscent of the past. Their intimate data harvested in real-time from ambient sensors fill their shadows and follow their movements throughout the exhibition space.**

Personal data overlays on projected family-film reels and scattered antique furnishings underscore the schism with privacy,

...providing a visceral awareness of unprotected intimate information.

Coupled with the visual experience is a musical score generated by links to gathered personal data. Nostalgic samples of oldie radio stations are manipulated into surreal soundscapes that resonate and contrast with home comfort.



Why DIGITAL INTIMACY?

Cyber breaches comprise the greatest criminal and national security threats of the 21st century.

In light of catastrophic corporate and government data breaches in recent years, an effective cybersecurity awareness tool galvanizing individuals to adopt responsible Internet habits to enhance the protection of their personal data and to insist on the same from businesses and government is essential.

DIGITAL INTIMACY is a traveling exhibition for reconfiguration in varied settings including corporate, hospital, hotel lobby, museum space, gallery space, conference, or boardroom space. A staffed workshop may accompany the exhibition to assist visitors implement cybersecurity measures on digital devices.



"DIGITAL INTIMACY is an excellent medium to make these security risks more tangible. I believe that by employing the established techniques and common, ubiquitous technology pervading the online experience, e.g. location tracking, as well as physical spaces, such as shopping malls, the installation has great potential for awareness, especially when juxtaposed with training workshops or a hands on security fair. I will be quite interested in running such an installation at VISA to make our staff aware of their responsibility to protect the company and its infrastructure."




About the Artist
